- The purpose of the body stocking is to replace your undergarments. A body stocking is typically worn underneath your leotard and tights. It is also very beneficial under costuming. It provides a clean line and eliminates your undergarments. Please purchase a flesh colored body stocking.
- Just a reminder, attire is part of your grade and a deduction will be made if the proper attire is not worn, worn incorrectly or adhered to for every class, rehearsal or performance.

What not to buy:

- Please do not buy leotards with attached skirts, jewelry or designs, Pointe shoes unless worn in the previous year's class, warm-up clothing or extra accessories unless it is requested in writing from one of our faculty members.
